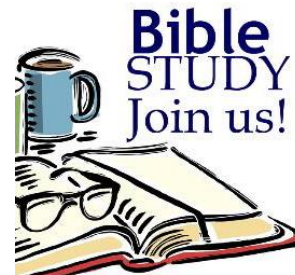
BIBLE TRIVIA:
