The name JUDE means "PRAISE OF THE LORD."

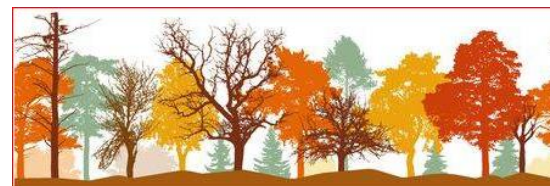
