Scripture of the Week: **Luke 2:14**

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

These are the words spoken by the Heavenly Host to the shepherds, heralding the birth of Jesus. Often these words are misunderstood - even by Christians. There is no peace on this earth, nor goodwill as men count peace and goodwill. The goodwill is of God towards men in the form of His only beloved son, whom he gave for the salvation of men. And the peace is between man and God through the blood

of Jesus Christ. The birth of Jesus that we celebrate did not usher in a new age of peace and harmony among men - but rather it incarnated man's only eternal hope for salvation and eternal peace with God.
